Old Business:

New Business:

Election of Officers. Doran made a motion to keep the office as is. J. R. seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Help needed to set up Fair Display.

District projects was the next item discussed. Soil mapping was discussed. Lee informed the Board of the VERIS Technology Company. The company designs, builds and markets soil sensors and controls for precision agriculture. Lee suggested the SWCD hold a workshop with the vendor by setting up a demonstration using the soil probes. The soil probe could provide help with the amount of fertilizer applied and how much nitrogen is in the plant. Mussoline will invite a specialist to the next SWCD board meeting to discuss the VERIS program.

Lee stated Suwannee County has an interagency meeting every month to discuss programs offered in that area. He suggested the Board could sponsor a breakfast meeting for the growers in our area.

Lee stated Hemp was approved as a commodity with the new farm bill.
