Sunshine organics collects food, agricultural, and forestry waste to process into nutrient rich compost and biochar. Product comes in bulk, individual, or bulk truck loads to farmers, foresters, landscapers, and other users. Biochar was discussed among the Board members. Biochar increases carbon, boots nitrogen, saves water and stabilizes PH in the soil. Biochar can be applied every 5 years. Brochures on the products were handed out for viewing. Kelcourse offered a tour of the facility located in Jacksonville.

Corn stated he would volunteer to do a trial plot of biochar on his farm.
